Birth of more than 17K twins in Iran

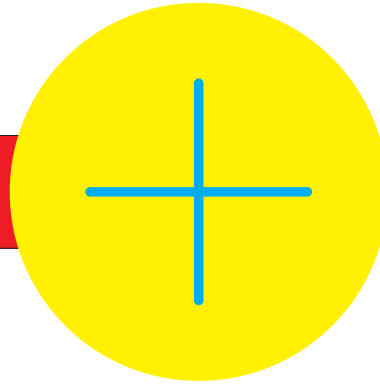
ISNA – Since the beginning of this Persian year (starting on March 21, 2022), 17,557 twins have been born across Iran.

Tehran Province leads the births with 2,814 twins, followed by Khuzestan Province with 1,307 and Khorasan Razavi Province with 1,200.

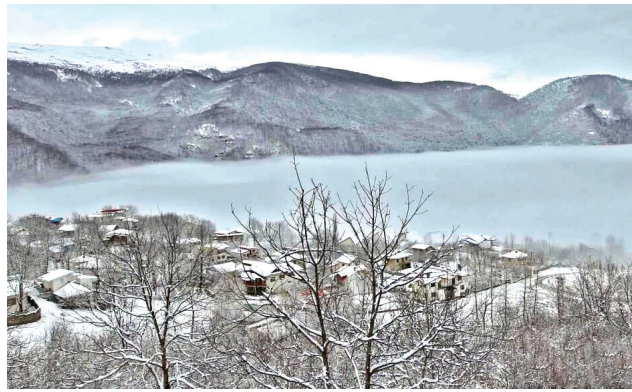
Best places in Iran to visit in winter

Winter in Iran

In Iran, winter shows different faces depending on the climate of the region. In some places it may go wild, while in other places it may be gentle and breezy. It can be said that winter in Iran has four different manifestations depending on the locality.

Cold and mountainous regions A Siberian winter rules in the cold and mountainous regions of Iran. If you like skiing, such places are heavenly. Alborz Province (close to Tehran) is a good place for such winter-time activity. It's important to bring warm clothing. East and West Azarbaijan, Ardebil, Alborz, Kurdistan, and Qazvin provinces are prototypes of such Iranian winter.

moderate climates has a different reputation. Humid and moderate climates include provinces on the shore of the Caspian Sea. It's mostly rainy and cold. Hot and dry regions

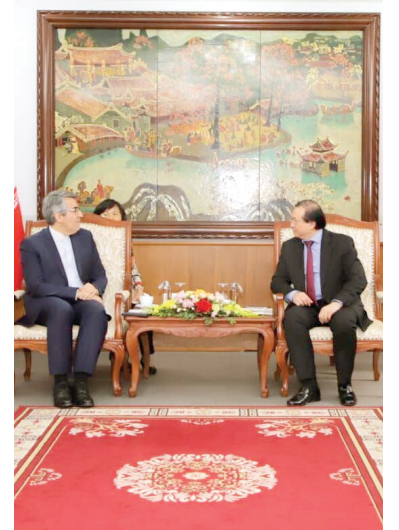

beautiful ports and on islands, the Iranian winter is very different from other parts. The winter in such places is another name for spring. The weather is so mild that at times you can go out in a t-shirt. Such places are great to visit in winter, for the weather is so mild and you won't drown in perspiration when you go out.
